Charitable Remainder Trust

Donor names the charitable organization as a beneficiary for the asset/gift upon death. Donor gets the income from the asset while alive.

Charitable Lead Trust

A trust designed to reduce beneficiaries' taxable income by first donating a portion of the trust's income to charities, such as the Foundation for the Future, and then, after a specified period of time, transferring the remainder of the trust to the beneficiaries. An excellent option for passing on some of your assets to your family while reducing or eliminating gift or estate taxes.



Life Insurance Gifts

Donor can name a charitable organization, such as the Foundation for the Future, as beneficiary upon death or is able to gift when alive.
