They taught this student how to talk even though she couldn't hear. She was the first child from the Center to be mainstreamed into 2rd grade at Roosevert-Wilson Figure nearly School. She was ready for a new challenge and continued to be an outstanding student in the fourth grade until she died of Leukertia. Only high school female students in their senior year at Texas City High School, Texas City, Texas, will be eligible to receive one of two \$1,000 scholarships to be awarded.

The recipient must have at least a 3.0 grade point average.

Completed application should be sent to the office of Ms. Tamara Jones, Scholarship Coordinator, by the end of the day on March 31, 2021.

A recipient must take a full load of 12 or more credit hours to qualify for the scholarship. The award must be used for tuition, books and fees and will be paid directly to the college or university the recipient attends. At the discretion of the trustees the scholarship may be renewed for three consecutive years (amount can vary from year to year) if a 3.0 grade point is maintained.
